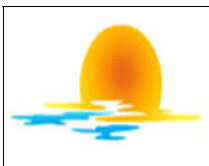

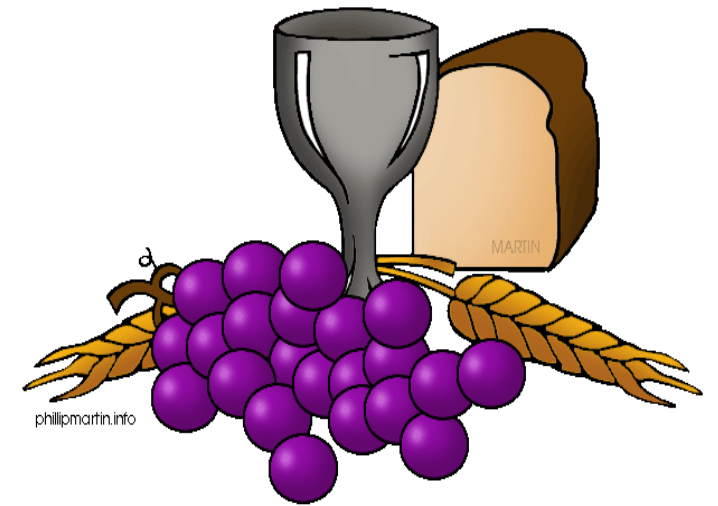
GOD's Provision for Humanity
