## Rahere – Part 2

Unsluce your briny floods,  
what can yee keepe

Your eyes from teares,

And see the marble weepe

Burst out for shame:

Or if yee find noe vent

This is a monument to a man desperately lonely, a man who felt that he would die without a friend. Though he accumulated much wealth, he knew that no tears would fall after he passed on. So he determined that at least his monument would shed a tear. It is made of hard, impervious marble. In the damp confines of the old church, the moisture slowly condenses on the head of Edward Cooke, runs down his forehead, until at last tears drop from the lifeless eyes. If no mourner was to be found for Edward Cooke, his monument would weep forever.

Two amazing monuments in London: the ancient church, born of personal crisis, and a pathetic cry for affection written in marble.

Rahere and Cooke were alike: they

both sought meaning in life. Both wanted the assurance that what they were accomplishing would be of enduring significance.

Both sought life's meaning. Only one found it. He who sought to chisel an eternal memory in history succeeded only in manifesting the poverty of the life that turns inward for its own gratification. He who submerged himself in working for the poor and the sick discovered that in turning outward from himself he found his true self.

*In the heart of London, only a few blocks from St. Paul's Cathedral and the Old Bailey, you may find two amazing monuments. And when you find them and reflect upon them, suddenly you realize that one of them—but only one—is your life's monument too.*

All who are legally blind (20/200 with corrective lenses) or have physical impairments which prevent them from holding a book to read are eligible for the following free services:

Subscription Magazines (Periodicals) Magazines are available in braille, in large print, and on audio CD.

Booklets -- Braille and large-print publications to inform and inspire.

Lending Library -- Over 1,400 book titles are available in braille and on digital cartridge through the CRSB library. Books can be checked out on a 30-day loan period.

Gift Bibles and Bible Courses -- Bibles and several Bible courses are available in braille, large print, solar player, and NLS digital cartridge.

Digital version of the Seventh-day Adventist Hymnal -- Software allows Seventh-day Adventist Church members to participate in congregational singing along with their sighted friends.

Full-Vision Books -- A combination of braille and print enables blind parents to read to their sighted children and sighted parents to help blind children learn to read braille.

Scholarship Assistance -- Partial scholarships are offered to legally blind young people striving to obtain a college education. Scholarships are given on a limited basis to those who qualify (United States only).
