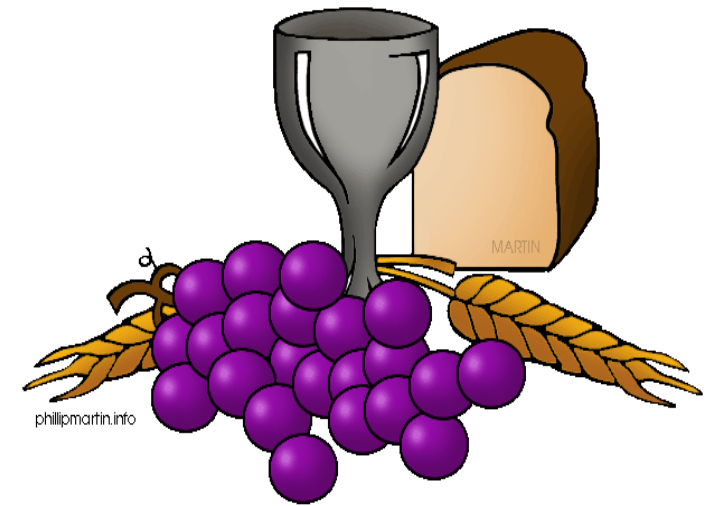
## GOD's Call for Loving Service
