GOD'S LESSON Book of Love

Apart from Christ we are still incapable of interpreting rightly the language of nature. The most difficult and humiliating lesson that man has to learn is his own inefficiency in depending upon human wisdom, and the sure failure of his efforts to read nature correctly. In their blindness they exalt nature and the laws of nature above nature's God.
