GOD's Call for Unity

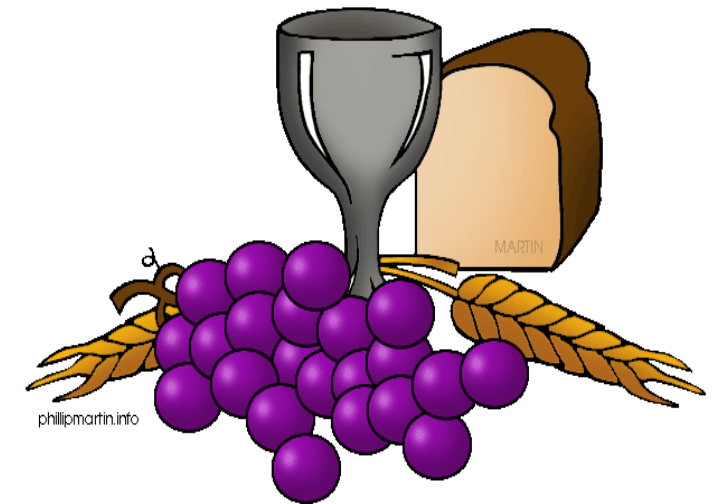
