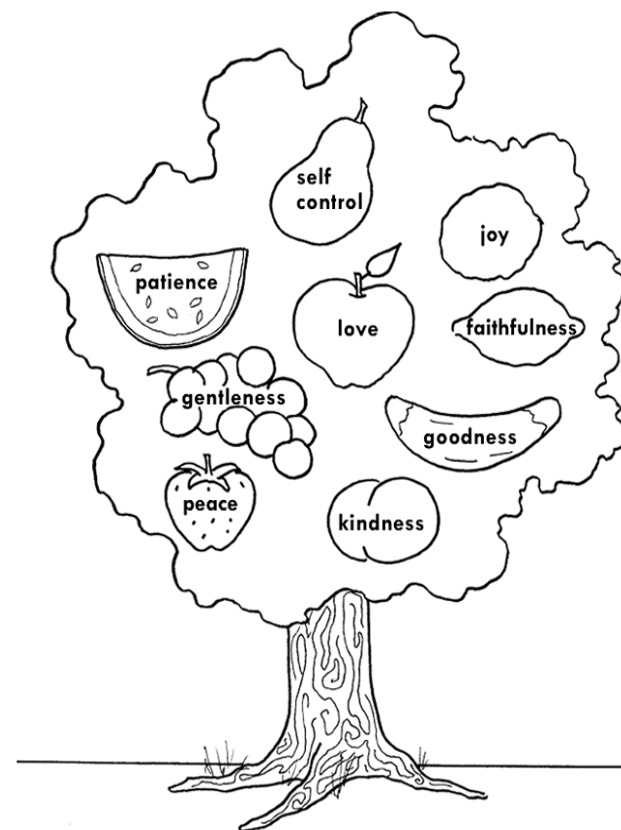
Our Holy EXAMPLE
